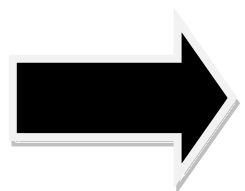

Behavior Issues

Campers that are having trouble behaving appropriately while attending the Armory Summer Camp will be issued a behavior document for acts that need to be addressed.

- It is the responsibility of each aide and camp counselor to complete a behavior document when any rules or guidelines are violated. The form must be completed by the employee witnessing the infraction.
- The camper receiving the document should be sent to the Armory Summer Camp office for discussion with Camp Director.
- The witnessing employee will discuss the incident with the child's parent upon arrival to sign the camper out for the day. Afterwards, the parent is to sign the form to acknowledge it has been seen. If the person picking up the child is not the parent, he/she is to sign the document regardless. The parent/guardian is given a copy of the signed document as desired.
- If behavior issues continue to occur campers will be subject to further discipline including up to expulsion from camp.
- Certain behavior issues can be subject to immediate suspension/and or expulsion from camp. In these cases, no refund for missed days of camp will be issued. These actions include, but are not limited to:
 - Physical violence towards another camper or counselor
 - Running away from camp
 - Inappropriate contact with another camper or counselor
 - Destruction of camp property
 - Theft
 - Self-harm

Assumption of Risk

This summer camp is not licensed through the state of Missouri. Participants must recognize that all activities of a physical nature involve some risk. By registering for an activity of this nature the assumption of risk is by the participant. The Columbia Parks & Recreation Department (CPRD) is dedicated to providing safe facilities and equipment for all participants, as well as qualified staff. The CPRD assumes no liability for personal injuries or loss of personal property of these persons participating or attending CPRD activities. It is the responsibility of the individual or the parents of the participant to notify CPRD of any physical limitations that may limit or impair their activity in the program for which they are registered. In event of a serious accident or illness, it is the policy of the CPRD to: (1) contact emergency dispatch (911) to perform first aid and when necessary recommend transport of victim to a hospital; (2) Reach parent or guardian as soon as situation allows. Persons desiring different procedures must notify the CPRD in writing at the time of registration. From time to time, photos of Armory Summer Camp campers will be taken and used on our website, social media accounts, and flyers. If you would prefer your child not be photographed, please make that known to camp staff in advance.
